



- 110 households receiving portable housing benefits through the Canada-Ontario Housing Benefit

2020 Accomplishments

- Successful transition to Yardi RENTCafé registry centralized wait list software and launch of portal for applicants to apply online for subsidized housing.
- Facilitation of Home for Good program, resulting in CMHA occupancy of 200 Larch Street in July 2020 for the Off the Street Shelter, Harm Reduction Home, and Nurse Practitioner Clinic; and signing of a contribution agreement for a Phase 2 capital project for 38 affordable units.
- Assisted two (2) community housing providers through Year 1 Canada Ontario Community Housing Initiative (COCHI) for capital repairs, and seven (7) community housing providers through Year 2 COCHI funding. The Urban Native Housing program received rent supplement funding to offset federal mortgage expiration.
- Assisted five (5) community housing providers through Year 1 Ontario Priorities Housing Initiative (OPHI) for capital repairs, and one (1) in Year 2 OPHI funding. Housing Services also assisted 24 low income rental households with down payment assistance through OPHI Home Ownership program.
- Successfully transitioned 38 community housing projects through major legislative changes within the Housing Services Act. 2011.
